PROVISIONAL TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

Subsidised Train Transport

If you live in Cambridgeshire you may be able to receive a discount for travelling to and from the College.

Rail operators **Great Northern & Thameslink** and **Abellio Greater Anglia** grant a 50% discount on selected routes to students attending a Cambridgeshire post-16 centre.

Students need to be under 19 years of age and in full time education to be eligible for the discount. Terms and conditions apply. Please see the following websites for details:
