This year the main fund raising events included the annual Community Lottery, a Wine Tasting event, a Quiz evening and the annual Hills Quiz Sheet. The profits go back to the College to benefit all the students in a variety of ways. Over the past few years the APF has raised over £12,000, and through this, has funded furniture in the Hub, signage for a conservation area, a cricket scoreboard and electronic tablets for use in lessons. We also supply refreshments for College events and parents' evenings. In the next academic year our main target is to raise funds to buy further IT equipment for use around the College.

When you join the Community Lottery your number will be entered into a number of draws with the chance to win prizes of £100, £50 and £25. The number of draws is determined by the number of people joining. It's easy to donate through Wisepay. Your Wisepay account will be set up once your daughter/son has commenced their course in September; at that time an email will be sent to you with further information about how to make payment using this system.

The APF team and I look forward to meeting you at the parent induction evenings in September, when the Association will provide refreshments and you can meet us to discuss other ways of helping with the work of the Association.
